

# Quick Easy-Peasy Scarf

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As the name says, this is a simple stitch pattern that makes a lovely, snugly scarf in very little time. Done in a bulky Lopi-type blend of alpaca, merino and bamboo it's super-soft and luxurious, too.

**Size:** approximately 7" (18 cm) wide by 70" (180 cm) long.

**Materials:** 6 oz (170 gm) Lopi-type yarn (5 wraps per inch/2.5 cm)  
Pair US 11 (8 mm) straight needles

## **Instructions:**

Loosely cast on 22 stitches.

Row 1: K3, \*yo, K2tbl, K2\*, to last 3 sts: end yo, K2tbl, K1.

Row 2: P3, \*yo, P2tog, P2\*, to last 3 sts: end yo, P2tog, P1.

Instructions inside the asterisks are repeated across the row.

Repeat these two rows until you're almost out of yarn, or the scarf is the length you desire. Cast off loosely, and you're done!

Note: slipping the first stitch of every row gives a neater edge.

## Abbreviations:

K = knit

K2tbl = knit 2 stitches together through back

P = purl

P2tog = purl 2 stitches together

YO = yarn over
